EPPR FACTS

EPPR is responsible for implementing the two legally binding agreements:

- The Agreement on Cooperation on Marine Oil Pollution Preparedness and Response in the Arctic (MOSPA)
- The Agreement on Cooperation in Aeronautical and Maritime Search and Rescue in the Arctic (SAR Agreement)

EPPR has two expert groups to facilitate follow-up to the Agreements - considering establishing a third expert group on radiation
